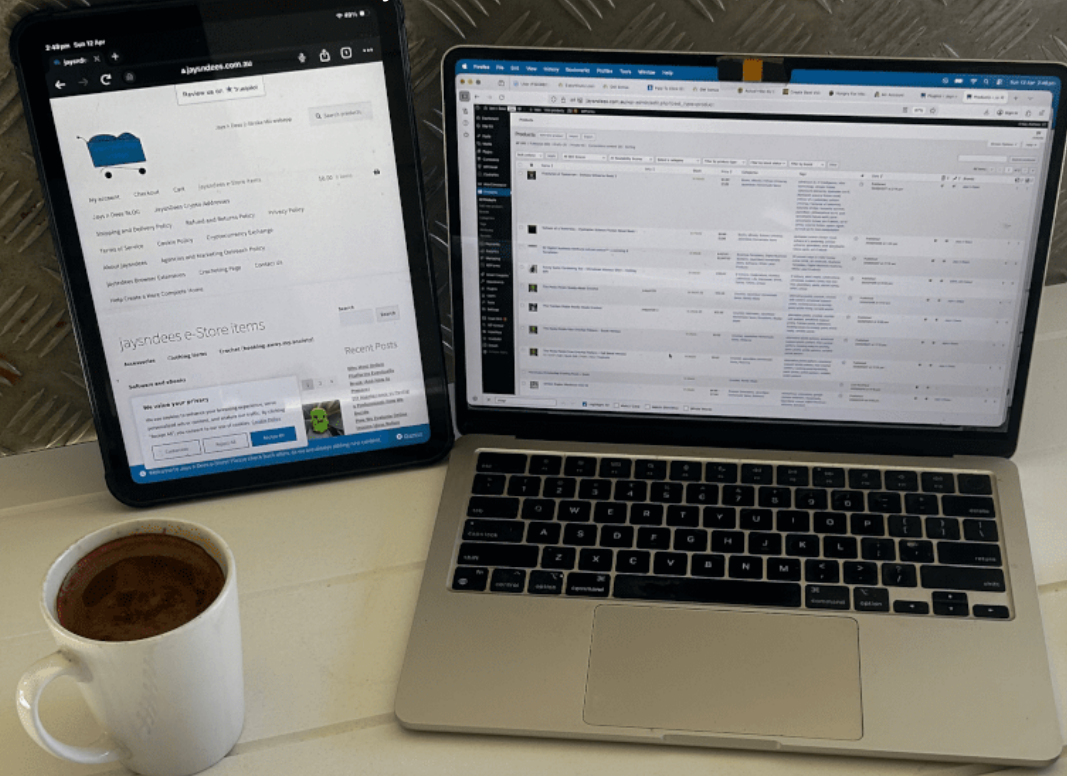

◆ SECTION 1 - The Simplicity Rule

Before choosing, understand this:

The model does not create income.
The system you build around it does.

Your goal is **NOT**:

- to find the best opportunity

Your goal **IS**:

👉 to choose something simple and build it

◆ SECTION 2 - The 5 Core Models

● 1. Blog-Based Model

You:

- create content
- attract visitors
- connect them to products

Makes money through:

- digital products
- affiliate links

Best for:

- long-term growth
- content-based systems

2. Digital Product Model

You:

- create a simple product
- sell it directly

Examples:

- PDF guides
- templates
- checklists

Best for:

- fast setup
- low cost
- simple systems

3. Print on Demand (POD)

You:

- create designs
- sell physical products

Examples:

- t-shirts
- mugs

Best for:

- visual creators
- product-based systems

4. Hybrid Model (Recommended Default)

You combine:

👉 product + content + traffic

Example:

- blog content
- digital product
- Pinterest traffic

👉 Most stable and flexible option

5. Service-Based Model

You:

- offer a service
- get paid directly

Examples:

- setup help
- simple freelance work

Best for:

- fastest path to income
- skill-based work

Blog	Slow	Medium	High
Digital Product	Fast	High	Medium
POD	Medium	Medium	Medium

If you want simplicity:

👉 Digital Product

If you want long-term growth:

👉 Blog or Hybrid

If you want fastest income:

👉 Service

If you want product-based:

👉 POD

🔑 **Default Recommendation:**

If unsure, choose:

👉 Digital Product + Basic Content (Hybrid)

◆ SECTION 6 - Model Commitment Rule

Once you choose:

Stay with it until your system is live.

Do NOT:

- switch models mid-way
- restart
- chase new ideas

👉 Finish what you started

◆ SECTION 7 - Red Flags in Model Selection

Avoid choosing a model based on:

- hype
- “easy money” claims
- what others are doing
- unrealistic expectations

👉 Choose based on what you can actually build
